How long does it take to install solar panels?

Once the scaffolding is up, the panels could be installed in less than a day. What should I do before reinstalling solar panels?

If water accumulates on these panels and drips to the inside, it can cause a short circuit. Use adhesive tape or silicone tape to hold the panels and everything else in place when reinstalling.
