

## How do I Keep my PC awake?

You can keep your PC awake by going to Settings > Power & Battery > Screen and Sleep. Choose "Never" for both battery and plugged-in options. Alternatively, install PowerToys from the Microsoft Store app and activate the "Awake" module to easily keep your PC awake or let it sleep according to your preference.

## How do I turn off my laptop battery?

On Windows, go to Settings > System > Power & Sleep and select "Never." On a Mac, go to System Preferences > Battery and drag the slider to "Never." On a Chromebook, go to Settings > Device > Power and click "Keep Display On." Open your Windows Settings. You'll find this gear icon in the Windows Start menu.
