How to find Maintenance Mode? Maintenance Mode can be found and activated via the Samsung Members app or through the Battery and device care service in the Settings menu. For instructions on locating it through Settings please follow the steps below.

How do I enable maintenance mode?

Here's how to do it: Head over to the Settings page and scroll down to locate Battery and device care. Select that and scroll down again till you find Maintenance mode, and tap it. Select the Turn on button on the Maintenance mode confirmation page. You'll now see a prompt asking you to create a system log before enabling the mode.

How to enable maintenance mode on Samsung Galaxy?

The Maintenance mode on Samsung Galaxy devices, as I mentioned earlier, has to be enabled manually before you hand over your phone to a technician for repairs. Here's how to do it: Head over to the Settings page and scroll down to locate Battery and device care. Select that and scroll down again till you find Maintenance mode, and tap it.

Maintenance mode is a feature that is designed to protect the personal data and information stored on your Galaxy smartphone or tablet when it is being repaired. Please note: Always backup your device before sending for repair as data could be lost.
