

How do I cancel a humidifier timer?

Move the humidifier away from walls or furniture. **TIMER** Press the timer button until the desired auto-shutoff timer setting is displayed. The timer button will cycle through the following settings: 4, 8, 12 hours and off. To cancel the timer at any time, press the timer button until all LEDs are off. **NOTE:** Always be sure the humidifier has a full tank of water.

How long should a humidifier run?

This usually means running your humidifier for 12 hours a day. Run the humidifier overnight to help you sleep. The recommended time for your humidifier to run depends on the current humidity level, type of humidifier, and room size. If you're suffering from a respiratory condition or illness, you may need to run the humidifier longer.

When is the best time to use a humidifier?

The best time to use your humidifier is when the humidity level is below 30% and no higher than 50%. However, as most people will not be able to determine the exact humidity level in their room (unless you own a moisture meter), a good rule of thumb is to use your humidifier during the winter.

How to use a humidifier in a dry home?

Using a humidifier correctly can greatly improve the living conditions in a dry home. Clean the water reservoir and fill it with distilled water. Place your humidifier at least 12 ft (3.7 m) from the wall on a level, elevated surface with good air circulation. Determine the proper settings, then plug it in and turn it on.

How do you maintain a humidifier?

Maintain humidity between 30-50%. Monitor with a hygrometer, refill the tank regularly, and change filters per manufacturer instructions. Disinfecting weekly helps prevent mold or bacteria buildup for healthier air. Clean the humidifier regularly to prevent mold and bacterial growth.

How do I know if my humidifier is full?

When one bar is illuminated green, your humidifier is at the lowest water level. Meanwhile, when there are two green bars, there is a medium water level. Three green bars means that the humidifier tank is full. When the tank is filled with water, the leftmost bar (level one) will flash a red light three times.
