

Will Laos become the 'battery of Southeast Asia'?

The government has ambitions to become the "Battery of Southeast Asia" by exploiting its impressive hydropower potential. By 2020-2021, an extra 50 hydropower plants with a total capacity of 5,606 MW will be in service. A total output of 27,024 GWh is anticipated and by 2025, Laos expects to export 14,600 MW to neighboring countries.

Does Cambodia import electricity from Laos?

The country currently imports 25 percent of its electricity from Laos, Vietnam and Thailand. The push for further electricity trade between the two nations emerges as Laos positions itself to become the "battery of Southeast Asia," while Cambodia enhances efforts to meet electricity demand as the economy rapidly expands.

How much electricity will Laos generate by 2039?

By 2039, the country expects to generate an additional 5,559 MW of electricity, with 77.59 percent of the capacity coming from hydropower. Although Laos relies heavily on electricity from hydropower dams, the country is also integrating other forms of renewable energy.

Is the Mekong River a 'battery of Asia'?

The mighty Mekong River, a life source for millions across Southeast Asia, now faces an existential threat. An ambitious regional plan developed by the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) incorporates the Lao People's Democratic Republic (Lao PDR) as the "Battery of Asia" to generate hydroelectric power for export across the region.

Why are electricity exports important in Laos?

In particular, electricity exports have benefited from high-profile foreign direct investment in the development of hydropower projects. Laos has an enormous hydropower potential of more than 18,000 MW, excluding the main stream of the Mekong River and up to 27,000 MW with it.

How many hydropower plants are there in Laos?

As of 2022, Laos has 94 power plants, including 81 hydroelectric dams, with a total installed capacity of more than 11,600 MW. By 2039, the country expects to generate an additional 5,559 MW of electricity, with 77.59 percent of the capacity coming from hydropower.
