What are unauthorized modifications?

Unauthorized modifications include but are not limited to: Whether you did or did not personally, at some point and time, some form of jailbreaking had to occur, and as such was confirmed by Apple when the device was undergoing diagnostic testing and/or inspection prior to completing service.
